Title: Slinger/Signaller

Duration: Four (4) consecutive days

TARGET DELEGATES

This course is aimed at inexperienced operatives who are required to undertake slinging and signalling for the movement of loads using lifting equipment. Candidates may be new to the role or may be those with limited experience and no formal training.

COURSE AIM AND CONTENTS

The aim of this course is to provide candidates with practical and theoretical knowledge in order for them to undertake the role of the Slinger/Signaller. Following successful completion of the course candidates will be able to select the correct lifting accessories, attach them to loads safely and guide the load using the appropriate hand signals.

CERTIFICATION

Successful candidates will be awarded an Ainscough certificate of training endorsed Slinger Signaller which will be valid for 5 years.
